Year 1 to Year 6 FAQs

IN 2025:

STUDENTS IN YEAR 1 – YEAR 4

All students in Year 1 to Year 4 are only permitted to wear items from our current uniform stock list.

No old uniform items are permitted.

STUDENTS IN YEAR 5 & 6

Students in Year 5 and 6 may wear:

Previous old school uniform
A mix of new / old uniform items

When wearing the FORMAL uniform:

The JACKET can only be worn over the navy school jumper, **it does not replace the school jumper.**



When wearing the SPORT uniform

The JACKET can be worn on top of the faction polo as the sport jacket.
The navy school jumper CANNOT be worn with the faction polo.

Personal Grooming & Accessories



Personal Grooming & Accessories

HAIR

- Should be natural and well groomed
- Long hair (over the collar) must be tied back and kept off the face
- **Should not be coloured or contain 'tracks'.**

HAIR ACCESSORIES:

- Only navy blue or white ribbons/scrunchies/clips may be worn

JEWELLERY

- A watch and small, plain sleepers or studs (one in each ear lobe) are permitted
- A simple metallic neck chain (Christian symbol) is also permitted

NAILS:

- Nail polish, acrylic nails and false nails are not permitted

MAKEUP:

- Makeup should not be worn
